CITY BLAZE bumped pinched back at the start, waited room around the turn, found a seem split rivals nearing the quarter pole, once freed from the herd drew away driving much the best. PLAYKOZ bumped at the start, trailer around the bend, knifed inside rivals nearing the furlong marker, rallied late to secure the place. HOLIDAY MUSICAL bumped at the start, set the pace off the rail around the turn, yielded in upper stretch, stayed on willingly to save the show. MOODY RIVER away in good order, urged along three wide around the turn, running on the wrong lead chased between rivals through the final sixteenth, evened out to the wire. BEACHGLASS clean break outside, pressed five wide around the bend, running on the wrong lead flattened out through the final stages. PIRINOLA bumped inside foe at the start, roused on six wide off the pace into the lane, came up empty through the stretch. AUNT POL bumped at the start, chased the pace inside around the turn, weakened upper. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
