MODERN MISS set the pace inside, lost the lead while being cued midway around the turn, tipped out to the three path in upper stretch, dug in gamely to fight back outside of the leader and edged clear in the closing stages. NUEVA LUNA broke thru the gate prior to the start, laid up close outside of an inner duo in the three path, bid for the lead around the turn, held command midway around the turn, then stayed on down the stretch, but got caught in the final sixteenth. BLUE OPAL trailed in the three path, swung out to the seven path turning into the lane, and improved for show. RUN MAMA RUN chased in the three path, was driven around the turn, but finished evenly down the stretch. PRIX raced off the pace in the three path but made no closing bid. LITURGIA prompted the pace between foes early but faded. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
