RED SHAHEEN roused to the lead from two wide to to midway down the backstretch then stayed on to press the pace to midway through the final turn, fell back slightly but made a rebid near the eighth pole and dug in with determined handling to be up in the final jumps. LOBO SALVAJE stalked the pace from three wide around the first turn then two wide down the backstretch and took the lead near the half mile marker, edged clear by upper stretch but was denied in the final jumps. BAMBY BOOM vied for the lead from the inside to midway down the backstretch then dropped back to settle off the pace to the top of the stretch, angled out to three wide in upper stretch to make the late rally and missed the place. PERMIT TO CARRY was unhurried around the first turn then raced five wide and was not a threat. CHENTI settled in the middle of the pack from off the rail but lacked a bid. RUN CECIL raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground then dropped back and was not a factor.
