TICKET TO FLY disputed the pace in the two path between horses down the backstretch, went clear leaving the far turn then increased her advantage through the lane while kept under pressure. LONIE MO broke slowly, advanced four deep leaving the far turn then flattened out. YAREE D TAT , four wide entering the first turn, left the far turn in the two path and rallied between horses. MARKET OF STOCKS hugged the inner rail disputing the pace and weakened in upper stretch. CANA GRIS , steadied in narrow quarters along the inner rail leaving the backstretch, swung five wide approaching the stretch and dropped back. WILDCAT DREAM hopped at the break, rushed up into the first turn, battled three deep down the backstretch and faltered.
