BALAM hard to load prior to the start, showed good early speed and disputed the pace four wide up the backstretch, vied for the lead three wide into the turn, took command nearing the quarter marker and led to upper stretch, drew clear into the final furlong and held sway late under hand urging. CAN OF CORN chased the early pace from outside of rivals, ran in pursuit three wide to the quarter marker, advanced while a bit green into the stretch, closed willingly into the final furlong, could not impact the winner into the final sixteenth but got up in time for second. PAPA ALDEN pressed the early pace three deep and from between rivals, vied for the lead nearing the quarter marker, was outkicked to mid-stretch, could not keep pace with the winner into the final sixteenth then was tagged for second at the wire, while holding clearly for third. COMMANDER'S COIN well placed while saving ground in the early going, angled four wide for the stretch drive, needed more into the final sixteenth and offered a mild late rally. MAX N' LOU disputed the early pace from the inside, lost position into the turn, shifted to the two path and chased to mid-stretch, could not find the needed late response and weakened in the final stages. SQUEAKY CLEAN settled in the second flight, ran in pursuit two wide nearing the quarter marker, swung widest for the stretch drive and did not threaten in the late stages. ATOMIC SNOW contested the early pace two wide and between rivals, pressed from the inside into the turn, lost position nearing the quarter marker then faded in the drive. MADCAP settled off of the early pace, trailed to the turn and did not offer a late response.
