ENVELOPE PLEASE disputed the early pace from outside of KOZY K, took command into the turn, shook free along the bend then kicked clear to upper stretch, drew off through the final furlong and was hand urged to the wire to win as much the best. KOZY K sent to dispute the early pace, lost position into the turn, chased three wide to upper stretch, was no match late for the winner and got up in time to earn the place honors. DOUBLE AGENT allowed to settle early on, advanced outside of rivals along the turn, swung four wide for the stretch drive, could not muster a final response and just missed for second, while just holding for third. GOT ZIP chased four wide to the turn, ran in pursuit of ENVELOPE PLEASE nearing the quarter marker, could not keep pace with the winner into the stretch, weakened in the late stages and was outfinished for the minor awards. LEROYISALAGNIAPPE tracked the early pace from the inside, gave way into the turn and could not muster a late response. MR. BALI tracked the early pace from between runners, was shuffled back nearing the half-mile marker, coaxed four to five wide into upper stretch, did not rally late.
