COUNT OF AMAZONIA (IRE) was well placed in the early going, tracked the solid pace while saving ground up the backstretch, tipped out at the quarter pole then rallied to upper stretch, closed determinedly in the final furlong, wore down the runner-up in deep stretch and edged away late to prove best. STRIDE sent for the early lead, set a solid pace while well handled to the far turn, showed the way to the quarter marker then met the bid of COUNT OF AMAZONIA (IRE) to mid-stretch, could not hold off the winner in deep stretch and was outfinished in the late stages, while besting the rest. ASSIDUOUSLY (GB) forwardly placed in the early going, tracked the pace two wide and between rivals up the backstretch, chased to the quarter marker then bid to upper stretch, was outkicked in the final furlong and held clearly for third. ENGLISH CHALLENGE off a bit slow leaving the start, unhurried early on, saved ground to the far turn, advanced nearing the quarter marker, saved all of the ground to upper stretch, lacked a final response and finished evenly. JUANITA'S EXPRESS settled outside of rivals in the early stages, raced four wide to the half-mile point, coaxed three wide to the quarter marker, could not muster the needed response and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. SOME R BLESSED prominent in the early going, stalked the pace two then three wide up the backstretch, lost position into the far turn and faded in the stretch drive. MISSION MIKE took back off of the early pace, raced widest up the backstretch, ran in pursuit four wide to the quarter marker, swung five wide to upper stretch and did not factor late. AUTHORITARIAN settled early on, trailed to the quarter marker, was asked for run two wide then from the rail into upper stretch, could not muster a late response. READY TO ROLL close up in the early stages,

stalked the pace from the inside into the backstretch, shifted out and chased two wide to the quarter marker, was outkicked to upper stretch and came up empty late. LEGAL TITAN settled while saving ground in the early going, shifted out into the backstretch, chased three then four wide to the far turn, lacked a response to upper stretch and faltered in the drive.
