PRIVATE SPEAKER was a little slow to get into stride, moved up late on the backstretch run to chased the leaders ffrom mid-pack, was under a ridet through the turn but advancing towards the front, got a fortunate opening turning into the stretch and responded when asked, surged to the lead and held clear under strong handling. BL FORTY was outpaced early, settled three-wide at the back moved up and circled the field four-wide on the turn, came five-wide into teh stretch and put in a strong finsih under handling but could not get to the winner. NANCY'S SHAWL pressed the pace two-deep, gained the upper hand near the quarter pole and came into the stretch with the lead but was overtaken by a pair of rivals in upper stretch and managed to save third. ANNALINE broke well, briefly vied three wide in the early pace battle, dropped off the pace before the three-furlong pole, came back on some when put under a stiff drive but flattened out in mid-stretch. I C GOLD dropped back to last after a fairly level start, dropped to the rail before the turn, raced through the stretch on the wrong lead and failed to rally. TAPTOGO contested the pace along the rail with two rivals, yielded the front to NANCY'S SHAWL midway though the turn, and tired in the stretch.
