BANG A RANG broke well and contested the early pace, backed off nearing the half, then rebid from midway on the turn, split horses in deep stretch, finished well, and prevailed in a blanket finish. MR FABRICATOR was away alertly but could not go with SAINT CHARLES through the turn, came back to gain a narrow lead in upper stretch, stayed on well to the wire, but was denied in the photo. AWESOME FANTASY tracked just behind the developing speed duel, advanced to join the leaders late on the turn, bid three-wide into the stretch, and was narrowly defeated in a three-way blanket finish. DR. PERRY was devoid of early speed and trailed the field, swung four-wide from the quarter pole, closed well late, but ran out of time. GOT GHOSTED was hustled from the gate to vie briefly for the lead, steadied near the three-eighths pole, and dropped to the rear, angled out in the stretch, closed ground willingly, but was too late. SAINT CHARLES was prominent four-wide early, then drew clear of the field approaching the half, crossed over to the rail, turned for home with a narrow lead, but weakened inside the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. AWESOME MOVE was slow into stride then under a ride to maintain contact with the main pack, made a mild bid in the late stages but was outkicked.
