FINSTER away in good order, vied three wide into the turn, looped six deep upper, drew away driving through the final sixteenth. GIANNO broke alertly, vied between rivals into the turn, shook off inside rival leaving the quarter pole, no match for winner through the lane, chased on willingly bested the rest. AERO STAR broke sharp, vied inside into the turn, lost ground nearing the quarter pole, under strong handling saved the show through the final stages. ONE BIG HAAS pressed inside in the second flight into the turn, angled off the rail bid between leaving the quarter pole, evened out through the final sixteenth. BIG HAMMER pressed five wide in the second flight into the turn, put to task six deep off the pace into the lane, had no late punch. SUPERSTAR SWANK chased three wide between in the second flight into the turn, roused four wide upper, had no late impact. ARJUN FOR KARZ pressed between runners into the turn, under pressure to keep pace around the bend, shuffled out lost contact nearing the quarter pole, faltered through the stretch.
