BABY DOLL PEACH set a pressured pace, drew clear entering the stretch and held well in a hand ride. HEAVENLY CAPTIVE was in tight and taken back entering the first turn, dropped inside to save ground, advanced on the turn, bid off the rail and won the battle for place. MARIAROSADELASERDA bumped at the start, was unhurried early and saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn, loomed a threat, hung late and settled for show. BLUES CROSS moved up outside along the backstretch to press the pace, swung out entering the stretch, dropped back and leveled off. NANCY'S SHAWL broke out and bumped at the start, was slow early, rallied around the turn, went widest in the drive and closed well. KAIA'S CHOICE pressed the pace, was through early and stopped. CHARGING DARLING was in tight and taken back into the first turn, moved up between horses to press the pace, tired into the second turn and stopped.
