INSTANT LOVE raced at the inside of the tracking flight around the first turn, chased at the rear of the main group along the inside down the backstretch, rallied up the inside from past the three eighths, went to a drive just behind DANCING BOOTS at the head of the stretch, responded with a rally inside of that foe, took the lead near the furlong mark and held sway. KAITSKATE raced between horses into the first turn, settled to track the leading pair down the backstretch, was driven and ranged up three wide on the far turn, loomed approaching the three sixteenths, could not match INSTANT LOVE's rally into the final furlong but chased on with interest to prove second best. DANCING BOOTS was reluctant to load, broke inward, was sent to the early lead, was prompted by RHYTHM READY to his outside down the backstretch, continued to lead inside foes around the far turn, was confronted by INSTANT LOVE in upper stretch, could not hold off that foe approaching the furlong mark and flattened between horses. ADD TO CART soon trailed while pulling inward early, continued to trail down the back straight while taking slightly closer order, rallied in the two to three path on the far turn, went to a drive into the lane, but chased on only mildly. RHYTHM READY raced three wide around the first turn, advanced to press outside of DANCING BOOTS on the backstretch and into the far turn, came up empty past the five sixteenths and weakened.

EIGHTYSIXCHEVY led from the outset, took some pressure from AWESOME FANTASY early before that one settled back near the nine sixteenths, was reengaged by that foe from the outside near the seven sixteenths but continued comfortably on the pace while saving ground, responded when asked in upper stretch and held sway. AWESOME FANTASY pressed in the early stages outside of EIGHTYSIXCHEVY, settled back and let that foe set the pace alone from near the nine sixteenths, raced three wide into the turn, rebid on EIGHTYSIXCHEVY in the three path past the seven sixteenths, was driven into the lane, proved no match when that foe was asked and chased on second best. AWESOME MOVE tracked well behind the leaders early, raced between horses into the turn, continued to chase two wide around the far turn, was driven into the lane, proved no match for the leading pair, but took mildly closer order late. LAWS OF MAN started slowly, bobbed in the opening strides and soon trailed, closed up ground up the inside gradually down the backstretch run, tracked inside of AWESOME MOVE around the bend while saving ground, went to a drive past the five sixteenths but nonetheless began to lose ground, floated out near the center of the course into upper stretch, and weakened.

BODENHEIMER was sent for pace and disputed three deep in the opening furlong, took a narrow lead approaching the turn, shifted in on PHILO BEDDOE near the three eighths, continued on the lead while saving ground around the bend, went to a drive in upper stretch and ran on resolutely. HIGH PROBABILITY broke inward, chased the leading trio down the back straight, saved ground around the turn while unhurried, swung three wide into the lane and responded when asked for a rally, could not reel in the pacesetter but ran on with interest for place. IT'S BOBS BUSINESS settled at the rear, chased in the four path on the turn, shifted six wide into the upper stretch, and improved belatedly for the show. PAT'S PADDOCK PICK came away quickly, vied inside of PHILO BEDDOE and BODENHEIMER early, settled back off that pair near the half, tracked that pair around the turn, swung four wide into the lane, chased on mildly through midstretch but flattened late and was caught for the show. PHILO BEDDOE vied between horses in the opening furlong, continued to press inside of BODENHEIMER approaching the turn, took up at the three eighths when BODENHEIMER came in, switched outside of that foe, rebid outside of him approaching the lane, proved no match from the three sixteenths despite being driven, and flattened out. GIANNO settled in second last early, was pushed along in the three path on the far turn, swung five wide into the lane, went to a drive but lacked the needed kick.

THUNDERS ROCKNROLL disputed the early pace inside of LOVER GIRL, edged to the lead past the nine sixteenths, set the pace in the two path on the turn while still being prompted by LOVER GIRL, took command into upper stretch and kept on well under a drive. CARSON BAY broke slowly and awkwardly, settled at the rear, raced at the inside of the rear flight while saving ground on the turn, went to a drive inside turning for home, proved no match for THUNDERS ROCKNROLL but chased on earnestly under a drive for the place. LOVER GIRL raced between horses in the leading flight early, pressed THUNDERS ROCKNROLL from the nine sixteenths, continued to press the leader two wide on the turn, went to a drive into upper stretch but could not match THUNDERS ROCKNROLL, and flattened out. ANN ALEE tracked the leading trio, continued inside of TAPTOGO on the turn, switched out past the five sixteenths, swung into the lane in the five to six path under a drive and lacked the needed response. TAPTOGO was three deep in the leading flight in the opening furlong, settled back past the five-furlong mark to track the leaders outside of ANN ALEE, was asked in the three to four path past the three eighths but had no response, and tired.
