Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

BL FORTY raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, began a bid entering the stretch, dueled in the lane and edged clear late. KIND KISMET raced in the middle of the pack on the outside through the opening quarter, navigated the bend from the three path, began a bid passing the quarter pole, dueled in upper stretch and chased the winner home through the final sixteenth. NANCY'S SHAWL dueled on the inside early, saved ground around the bend and dug in gamely in the lane, giving way late. VINTAGE PORT raced off the pace on the inside up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the three and four path and passed tiring horses in the lane. INSTANT LOVE dueled between horses up the backstretch, continued to battle from the two path coming around the bend and weakened in the stretch. I C GOLD raced off the pace on the outside through the opening stages, came around the turn in the three path and made no bid. RHYTHM READY pressed the pace on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the two path and tired in the lane.
