Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. Purse \$29,500 (Includes \$5,000 from the MQHRA) (Includes \$5,000 from the Minnesota Breeders' Fund) of which 50% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 15% to third, 10% to fourth, and 5% to fifth. Weights: Three year olds - 125 lbs.; Older - 127 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Bob Morehouse Stakes will be limited to ten (10) starters. Preference will be given to horses with the highest total earnings in 2025-2026 at time of entry. Canterbury Park reserves the right to refuse any nomination or entry into this race or to cancel, change or postpone this race. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The final purse will be reduced by the cost of any Out of Competition testing required by the Minnesota Racing Commission as a condition of competing in this race. DANCING BOOTS took early command, set a modest pace to the half-mile marker, met oncoming bids nearing the quarter pole, dug in into the final furlong, kept foes at bay to the final sixteenth and kept to task late. ADD TO CART settled while saving ground in the early stages, angled three wide into the far turn, challenged DANCING BOOTS into the stretch, could not get by the determined winner into the final furlong but was a clear second best. MAY SURPRISE rated off of the modest early pace, coaxed two then three wide nearing the half-mile marker, angled in into the far turn, ran in pursuit to upper stretch, could not impact the top pair past mid-stretch but kept on late to be a clear third. FROSTED PEACH forwardly placed early on while three wide, went up to press the modest pace outside of DANCING BOOTS along the backstretch, dueled that one into the far turn, was turned away into upper stretch then yielded in the final furlong. LONE ARROW broke in and crowded a bit at the start, was unhurried to the backstretch, trailed to the far turn, kept an inside path to the stretch and did not threaten in the final stages. ADRIENNE'S BALBOA prominent in the early stages, stalked the pace between rivals into the backstretch, gave chase into the far turn, could not find more nearing the quarter marker and tired in the stretch.

YOU AND R US broke alertly, showed good speed and assumed early command, set the pace to the turn then met the bid of ITS BILLY BAROO nearing the quarter marker, dug in to upper stretch and held that rival at bay into the final furlong, kept to task into the final sixteenth and proved best late. ITS BILLY BAROO crowded and pinched back at the start, rushed up into the turn then pressed YOU AND R US nearing the quarter marker, a bit green to upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong, could not get by YOU AND R US in the late stages and was a clear second best. HEY BABY MIKKO close up to the early pace, chased between rivals into the turn then was caught a bit in tight midway along the bend, ran in pursuit of the top pair into the lane, was no match for those two past mid-stretch but kept on late to secure the show honors. FORGED WITH FYRE prominent in the early going, chased from the rail heading into the turn, caught in tight and checked off of heels leaving the seven-sixteenths marker, swung out and chased three wide to the stretch, ran in pursuit into the final furlong and was outkicked for the show honors. BOLT OF LUCK bobbled and off slow to begin, raced widest to the turn then maintained a wide trip to the stretch, could not impact the leaders in the final sixteenth but improved position late. PHANTOM EXPRESS broke alertly, showed good speed from the gate and took early command, showed the way into the turn then met the bid of KALATUA nearing the quarter pole, repelled that foe into the stretch, drew off under urging into the final furlong then was ridden out to win as much the best. MIGHTY ARMY a bit slow away from the gate, settled while saving ground into the turn then kept an inside path to the stretch, was no match for the winner but kept on in the late stages to earn the place honors. KALATUA tracked the early pace from the second flight, went up to vie for the lead two wide nearing the quarter marker, had that bid turned away into upper stretch, could not keep pace with the winner into the final furlong then was outfinished for the place, while holding for the show. ZELOS prominent in the early going, chased the pace from the second flight heading to the turn, lost ground passing the quarter marker, could not find more into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SPEAKING LOUD broke in at the start and was off a bit slowly, lacked speed to the turn, was coaxed along from the rail to upper stretch then failed to threaten in the late stages. KING OF THE TRAIL settled in the early stages, was outrun to the quarter pole and did not factor in the stretch drive. ROCKNSOCKCONNECTION broke in the air at the start then was a bit erratic in the early going, bolted along the turn then was pulled up along the bend, walked onto the equine ambulance and was transported off of the course.
