HEY RIVER contested the early pace from between runners then took command into the backstretch, led into the far turn and kicked clear to upper stretch, kept to task into the final furlong and held safe late over the runner-up. INDIE FREEDOM close up to the early pace while three wide, chased HEY RIVER to the far turn then outkicked by that one into upper stretch, fought on while in pursuit into the final furlong, was gaining on the winner late but couldn't reel in HEY RIVER and was a clear second best. HOLIDAY FANTASY off slow and unhurried early, saved all of the ground to the far turn, bid between rivals to upper stretch, couldn't impact the top pair into the drive but closed the gap late and was a clear third. OUT RUN'M close up to the early leaders then took back, chased from the inside heading to the half-mile pole, waited for racing room approaching the far turn, ran in pursuit three wide to the quarter pole, lacked the needed response in the lane and weakened. TIGER HUNTER off slow, settled two wide to the backstretch, trailed to the top of the lane and did not factor late. SECRET POTION showed good early speed, disputed the pace from the inside heading into the backstretch, dueled inside of HEY RIVER into the far turn then couldn't keep pace nearing the quarter pole, had little left for the stretch drive and tired.
