KALATUA settled at the rear, shifted four wide while racing on the turn to join outside the chasing flight, came four wide into the lane, rallied well when shaken up in upper stretch, drove to the lead near the sixteenth and prevailed. T C GOLD was sent hard for speed, dueled inside of KID GOT RHYTHM into the turn and into the lane, dug in when challenged by KALATUA, could not hold off that foe in the final sixteenth but fought on to outfinish KID GOT RHYTHM for the place. KID GOT RHYTHM pressed outside of T C GOLD early, engaged outside of that foal to separate from the rest of the field and duel on the lead, continued to battle between horses through midstretch, but was narrowly outfinished. PILOT'S CREED chased two wide, was pushed along on the turn while two wide between horses, proved no match for the top three into the lane but chased on mildly to prove best of the rest. MIGHTY ARMY chased midpack inside, raced keenly while saving ground on the turn, and had no rally in the lane. NOW THEN raced keenly while tracking three deep on the backstretch, did not go with T C GOLD and KID GOT RHYTHM into the turn, chased three wide between horses around the bend, was driven in upper stretch and came up empty.

THAT TYPE OFA DEAL raced at the rear, ran under a hold around the far turn and into the back straight, was allowed to improve between horses on the far turn, swung out into the lane and drifted out near the center of the course, nonetheless kicked on with his best from the sixteenth, showed good energy while drifting in a few paths late and seized the lead in the last six jumps. PERFECT GAMBLE tracked behind the pacesetter NAVARRE around the first turn, chased inside a foe while still well off the rail down the back side, edged into closer range of NAVARRE, raced in the two path on the far turn, rallied inside of that foe past the quarter pole to seize the lead, drifted out under a drive, kept the lead inside the sixteenth mark but was caught by THAT TYPE OFA DEAL. NAVARRE broke sharply, set the pace while racing well off the rail, continued on the lead in the four path on the far turn, was caught by PERFECT GAMBLE to his inside past the quarter pole, chased on between horses in the lane but did not have enough to reel him back in and had to settle for the show. HOW BOUT THAT CURT tracked outside of PERFECT GAMBLE, edged closer to the leader down the back straight, chased in the four to five path on the far turn, but had no response under a drive.

LORD KNOWS raced a bit keenly early, chased inside around the first turn, settled at the rear of the main field down the backstretch, raced in the two path on the far turn, swung five wide into upper stretch for room, rallied under a drive and got up outside foes inside the final sixteenth. BATTER UP settled near the rear, raced two wide into the backstretch at the rear of the main pack, improved in the three path on the far turn, swung four wide into the lane, rallied between horses under a drive but was outkicked by LORD KNOWS to his outside. HAUNTED HAZE chased two wide on the first turn, was keen to take closer order down the back straight, improved into the far turn and loomed three wide near the three eighths, battled to the lead approaching the furlong mark, but was engaged by BATTER UP and LORD KNOWS shortly thereafter and could not hold them off in the final sixteenth. MENDELSSOHN JOY chased well behind the leading pair, took closer order down the back straight, chased in the three path on the far turn while racing midpack, was driven in the lane, and chased on mildly to prove best of the rest. BANG A RANG was put on the lead, was engaged in earnest past the half mile by HOT LEGS ROMOLO, was headed near the three eighths but continued to battle on inside foes until just outside the eighth pole, and flattened inside. HOT LEGS ROMOLO tracked the leader while well clear of the rest of the pack early, engaged the pacesetter approaching the half-mile mark, dueled outside that foe around the turn and into upper stretch, but came up empty between horses from the three sixteenths. LEMON SOHN settled at the rear, continually lost ground, trailed in the two path on the far turn and was never involved.

CHARLIES MINT led early, cleared into the turn, set the pace in the three to four path around the bend, responded to improve her lead when asked in the lane and remained well clear to the wire. DR. PERRY was unhurried early, began to take closer order approaching the quarter pole, rallied between horses with good interest in the lane and proved best of the rest. PROMISES acted up behind the gate and was loaded without a rider, broke outward, raced at the rear between horses early, was near the rear outside FLATTER ME BILLY down the back straight, chased toward the rear around the far turn while racing in the three to four path, swung out to the seven to eight path under a drive into the lane and came up empty.

THUNDERS ROCKNROLL tracked the pacesetter, was pushed along near the seven sixteenths to rally outside of CARSON BAY, led past the three eighths, carried a narrow lead over CARSON BAY into upper stretch, shook that foe off near the three sixteenths, drifted inward in upper stretch while narrowly clear of CARSON BAY, and rolled to an insurmountable advantage under a mild drive. CARSON BAY set the pace down the backstretch and while saving ground into the turn, was engaged by THUNDERS ROCKNROLL to her outside past the seven sixteenths, lost the lead to that foe near the three eighths but fought on doggedly, remained in contention to upper stretch, shifted out behind THUNDERS ROCKNROLL after that runner was narrowly clear in upper stretch, and chased on with interest under a drive to prove second best. LOVER GIRL chased well off the leading pair, was soon joined from the outside by BL FORTY, raced at the inside of the rear flight in a compact field into the turn, saved ground around the bend, proved no match for the leading pair from near the three eighths, gave chase down the lane and finished well clear for show despite drifting out several paths in the lane. HEAVENLY DESTINY raced near the rear early, was relegated to the rear past the five eighths, raced around the turn three wide in the rear flight, and lacked the needed rally under a drive in the lane. BL FORTY broke last, was keen between horses near the eleven sixteenths, chased two wide toward the rear down the back straight, raced around the turn between horses in the rear flight and came up empty in the lane. THE JOCKEY OF CARSON BAY CLAIMED FOUL ON THUNDERS ROCKNROLL, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE INTO UPPER STRETCH. UPON REVIEW, STEWARDS DETERMINED THUNDERS ROCKNROLL WAS CLEAR AND MADE NO CHANGE.
