PAT'S PADDOCK PICK broke quickly, pressed the pace outside of BODENHEIMER, engaged outside that foe in a duel while racing two wide near the three eighths, kept on with interest even when that foe briefly kicked in front in upper stretch, began to reel BODENHEIMER back in from the furlong mark, was grazed by that foe late as he drifted out but nonetheless overtook him for the lead near the sixteenth mark, and dug in to deny a late run from ATHENS MOON. ATHENS MOON chased the leading pair while racing inside of IT'S BOBS BUSINESS down the backstretch and in the two to three path on the turn, responded when put to a drive approaching the furlong mark, rallied well inside of BODENHEIMER, passed that foe, and missed catching PAT'S PADDOCK PICK by the narrowest of margins. BODENHEIMER was hustled hard to get the early lead over PAT'S PADDOCK PICK, was engaged from the outside by that foe near the three eighths, dueled until the turn for home, briefly kicked clear into upper stretch, was reengaged by PAT'S PADDOCK PICK inside the furlong mark, drifted out slightly and grazed that foe, was caught near the sixteenth mark and flattened between horses. CHROMED IMPULSE settled at the rear, raced in the four path on the turn, floated into the lane in the five to six path, and made a belated rally in the final furlong. IT'S BOBS BUSINESS chased outside of ATHENS MOON, was pushed along outside that foe while racing in the three to four path on the turn, went to a drive into the lane, chased on with interest to the wire but was ultimately outkicked.

TAKING IT ALL was sent to the lead inside horses while taking early pressure from the outside, was pushed along in the two path to improve her lead on the turn, floated into the lane in the four path, and kept on under steady urging to maintain her advantage to the wire. SMART WITH HEART broke inward and grazed QUEEN ATLAS in the opening strides, settled at the rear, was nudged along in the five path on the turn, came into the lane in the six path, and gained well belatedly to capture the place. PAARL prompted the early pace three wide, settled back to chased past the half-mile mark, was pushed along in the four path on the turn, dropped toward the inside into the lane for the drive, chased on with continued interest, but could not reel in TAKING IT ALL and lost the place late. HONORABLE MISCHIEF tracked the leading trio, hugged the rail on the turn and into the lane, shifted out in upper stretch for room to get around PAARL but could only run on evenly. QUEEN ATLAS was grazed by SMART WITH HEART early, pressed the pace between horses on the backstretch, continued to press the pace into the turn but steadily weakened from the three eighths.

ROSE VIEW chased two wide early, began to edge closer approaching the far turn, kicked on in earnest in the three path near the three eighths, swung four wide into the lane, overhauled the pacesetter past the three sixteenths mark and opened up under a mild drive. TOFFEE settled near the rear, took closer order down the back straight inside of ROSE VIEW, did not follow that one when she kicked on in earnest near the three eighths but rather remained unhurried in the three path outside of DUTTON STREET GIRL, swung six wide to rally in tandem with that foe, proved no match for the winner but outkicked DUTTON STREET GIRL for the place. DUTTON STREET GIRL tracked the early pace inside, took a bit closer order past the five eighths, was shuffled back a bit into the turn as ROSE VIEW commenced her run to the outside, raced in the two path around that bend, swung out into the lane five wide, rallied in tandem inside of TOFFEE, kept on with interest but narrowly missed the place. CAYMAN HOT settled at the rear, continued at the rear in the two path on the far turn, swung three wide into the lane and ran on mildly past tiring horses. REBEL GAL vied inside of MINNESOTA ROSE into the first turn, shook to the lead, set the pace down the back straight and while saving ground around the far turn, had no answer when ROSE VIEW descended to her outside past the three sixteenths and weakened. MINNESOTA ROSE vied outside of REBEL GAL into the first turn, tracked that pacesetter down the backstretch, was pushed along in the two path to keep up but had no answer when ROSE VIEW rallied past to her outside, and came up empty inside in the lane.

MIRACLE BALL was put on the lead, set the pace down the back straight and in the two path on the turn, raced into the lane in the three path while still setting the pace, went to a drive in upper stretch, drifted out slightly but was never threatened. LONG GONE SALLY was a bit slowly away but soon improved to track the pace between horses, was pushed along between horses into the turn, tracked in the three path around the end while still positioned between runners, floated into the lane in the four path, proved no match for the leader but kept on well enough to get up for place inside the final sixteenth. SMOOCHERRO raced keenly behind the leader inside early, tracked the pace along the rail around the turn, was driven inside in upper stretch when there was a gap between MIRACLE BALL and the fence, did not have enough to get through that hole, flattened in the final furlong but narrowly salvaged the show. ASK THE MONARCH broke with the leaders but was outsprinted and soon relegated to last in a compact field, chased in the four path on the turn, swung out into the lane in the six path under a drive, made belated improvement but just missed the show. BELLA MENDY tracked the pace three wide, continued three wide in range around the turn, floated out into the lane in the five path and had no rally.

LIEUTENANT CHARM settled at the rear around the first turn, raced four wide on the back straight, began to improve from the half, made a circling five-wide rally on the far turn, bore down outside of LOCO POR SER LIBRE and ENGLISH ICON in upper stretch, cleared through midstretch, and held on. LOCO POR SER LIBRE chased three wide on the first turn and midfield down the backstretch, was sent to rally between horses near the three eighths, engaged outside of ENGLISH ICON near the quarter, had no answer for LIEUTENANT CHARM in upper stretch and looked to be weakening but was able to find a late re-rally to overtake ENGLISH ICON narrowly for place. ENGLISH ICON tracked two wide around the first turn, tracked inside of DAYS IN DUBLIN down the back straight, engaged outside of THIRTYNINE TIMBERS near the three eighths and took the lead, was engaged by LOCO POR SER LIBRE to his outside near the quarter pole, fought back inside that foe through upper and middle stretch as LIEUTENANT CHARM passed to their outside, gained on the winner late but was nonetheless outfinished for the place.
