## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

SUMMER WINNER broke alertly to quickly take command, opened a clear lead to the turn, responded when challenged by the runner-up nearing the quarter pole, dueled with that one through the lane briefly surrendering the lead in mid-stretch and came again gamely up the fence to prevail in deep stretch. INCREDULOUS trackd the leaders to the turn, rallied five wide to engage the winner at the quarter pole, vied on the lead briefly taking the advantage midway down the stretch and was outfinished in the final yards settling for second best in a good effort. FLATTER ME BILLY reserved off the early pace, commenced a steady advance early on the turn along the rail, angled six wide to the clear leaving the quarter pole and mounted a good stretch rallly. HAY Y'ALL stalked the pace from four wide to be well placed on the turn and lacked a closing kick running-on willingly through the lane to hold for a minor award. HEAVENLY CAPTIVE raced mid-pack along the fence saving ground, cut the corner coming for home and showed some interest in the lane with a mild bid. TAPTOGO was well placed tracking the leaders from the inside through the turn, tipped out to the four path in the lane and finished with mild interest between rivals down the stretch. KAITSKATE was one-paced failing to menace. GIVEMEACOOKIE raced near the rear of the field to the head of the lane and passed weaker foes in the lane. RHYTHM READY was never a threat. NANCY'S SHAWL shwoed speed pressing early after breaking well and came up empty after a half. CHARGING DARLING was never a factor.
