TEST PILOT saved ground setting the pace under pressure from DEFLATER and MAGOO, opened a clear lead nearing the eighth pole and prevailed under strong handling. MAGOO was prominently placed early racing two-wide, dropped back slightly nearing the eighth pole then came on again late to be catching the winner at the wire in a fame try. MT. ZEROR was unhurried early, came two-wide into the stretch and rallied late. STUCK N SNOW raced in the back of the field early, came three-wide into the stretch, angled in during the drive but failed to seriously threaten. DEFLATER prompted the pace for five furlongs while three-wide and tired.
