CLIFF DIVER was forwardly placed racing three-wide, took the lead from ANGEL'S MAGIC nearing the quarter pole and gradually increased his advantage. PEPPER JACK was allowed to settle, moved up strongly four-wide nearing the quarter pole but was unable to match strides with the winner during the drive but finished well for second. MYSTIFIER was unhurried early, rallied five-wide into the stretch and rallied late. CHASENTHEONE checked entering the first turn lacking room the saved ground while being allowed to settle, came two-wide into the stretch and went evenly late. HAY MOON prompted the early pace racing two-wide and weakened. ANGEL'S MAGIC saved ground setting the pace to near the quarter pole and tired when headed.
