SIR STERLING was forward three wide early, pressed IT'S BOB'S BUSINESS into the turn, vied with him while racing to his outside in the six path, headed that foe near the five sixteenths, continued to vie under hand urging in upper stretch after his rider lost the crop near the three sixteenths, kicked clear approaching the furlong mark and cleared under a vigorous hand ride. IT'S BOBS BUSINESS was nudged inside foes to get to the lead, set the pace in the five path on the turn while pressed by SIR STERLING to his outside, was headed by that foe at the five sixteenths and continued to vie inside him into upper stretch, proved no match from the furlong mark, and chased on second best while drifting out a few paths. IT'S MILES settled at the rear, was urged inside of PERFECT GAMBLE in the rear flight into the turn, saved ground around the bend, swung out to the six path for the drive, and chased on mildly past a tiring horse for the show. SUPERSTAR SWANK was fractious in the gate and had to be unloaded and reloaded, was hustled out of the gate and briefly contested the lead four deep before settling back to track the leading pair, was urged in the two path on the turn, briefly loomed inside of IT'S BOB'S BUSINESS while trying to make a bid inside turning for home, but could not match the top two from the head of the stretch, flattened inside, and lost the show late. GOT GHOSTED was forward between horses in the opening furlong, settled back to track the leading pair from near the nine sixteenths, saved ground midpack around the turn and lacked the needed rally in the lane. NAVARRE chased midfield, was pushed along near the seven sixteenths and continued to chase in the four path around the turn, floated into the lane near the center of the track and came up empty. PERFECT GAMBLE raced toward the rear down the backstretch and in the three path on the turn, was driven in the six path into upper stretch and offered no rally.
