KNICK'S HONOR showed good early foot to set the pace, dug in through the stretch, came in bumped Tamarack at the eighth pole, sixteenth pole, stewards inquiry was filed and Knick's Honor was disqualified and placed second for interference. TAMARACK stalked the pace, had an inside run, bumped soundly near the eighth pole, sixteenth pole and kept on gamely to the wire. OSCARS ANGEL raced four wide around the first turn, settled off the early pace, made an early two wide bid near the quarter pole and kept on gamely to the wire. MR MO'S MAGIC prompt the early leader two deep between rivals and weakened a bit through the drive. HALLOW'S ICE was unhurried early, moved up three to four wide around the far turn and was even in the drive with no closing run. CAMPAIGN QUOTE raced far back and never threatened. TAKE A CHANCE INDY stalked the top pair three deep and was done early. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time available.
