SPEEDSTORM vied two wide and between horses early on, then only with his outer counterpart while remaining a path off of the inside around the turn and kicked away in upper stretch. TRIPP'S PROMISE pursued from midpack along the inside, shuffled back into the turn, steadied in tight inside of rivals passing the five sixteenths pole, tipped to the two path entering the lane then rallied to edge place from outer rivals in the final furlong. TAMINO chased forwardly three to two wide and between horses, brushed an outer foe while moving to the four path in upper stretch, ran on to bid for place between horses

at the furlong grounds, but got outkicked by his inner counterpart then held show. WEAREBACKYOUNGMAN brushed with an outer foe soon after the start, pursued from midpack in the four path and between horses, floated six wide entering the lane, brushed with an inner foe in upper stretch, ran on to bid for place at the furlong grounds, but got outkicked then was denied show. ARMY WILDCATTER brushed with an inner foe after the start, raced off of the pace in the four to three path, swung out to the seven path in upper stretch and moved up. LIL MUGGS pressed from the four path, brushed with rivals on both sides while chasing in the five path in upper stretch then faded. GOOD MOJO pursued from midpack in the five to six path and gave way. CLOCKER SPECIAL vied for the lead with an outer pair early on, chased into the turn and faded. SOUTHERN BULLET broke a beat slow, trailed in the four path, shifted out to the six to seven path in upper stretch and failed to factor. MCILROY vied three wide early on, then only outside of the eventual winner while kept in the three path around the turn, proved no match for that one in upper stretch then steadied while weakening between rivals in midstretch.
