LEXI'S MELODY brushed with an outer rival at the start, tracked along the inside, bid inside of the leader in upper stretch, forged an advantage into midstretch, battled with an outer co-bidder through the final furlong and held firm. RELEVATE pressed two wide, chased the clear leader around the turn, bid in the four path along with an inner foe in upper stretch, dueled with that one through the final furlong but was denied. BERLINWIN stalked three to two wide and between horses, chased while moving out to the four path in upper stretch then stayed on to hold show. PREACH TEWMEY NOW broke slowly, trailed along the inside, offered a rail rally to vie for show in the final sixteenth but missed at the wire. CRYSTAL FROST brushed with an inner foe at the start set the pace near the inside, built a clear advantage around the turn, vacated the inside in upper stretch before yielding between bidders nearing the final furlong grounds and gave way. LET 'ER SIZZLE tracked five to three wide then tired while floating to the five path entering the lane. KYLER raced off of the pace in the four to five path into the lane and weakened.

ICEBREAK vied for the lead with an outer pair into the turn, yielded to them passing the five sixteenths pole, shifted to the four path to take aim in upper stretch, progressed to rebid outside of them at the furlong grounds then edged past. BON VOYAGE hopped slightly at the start, traded bumps with an inner foe shortly after, vied three wide into the turn, dueled two wide into the lane, exchanged contact with his inner counterpart in upper stretch, battled between horses into the final furlong then got outkicked late. CLONMACNOISE vied two wide and between horses, sparred with his outer counterpart into the lane, traded bumps in upper stretch, got headed once inside of a pair of rivals in the final furlong and yielded late. CROSS POWER raced off of the pace along the inside, chased around the turn, pursued evenly into midstretch then tired through the final furlong. CAMPING SIETE traded contact with an outer rival through the opening stages, raced off of the pace two wide and between horses into the turn, shifted to the four path at the three furlong pole and gave way. STAZITTO chased in the five to three path into the turn, retreated to trail while getting floated to the five path at the three furlong pole and was outrun thereafter.

URBAN PLANNER laid off of the pace along the inside, took aim in the three path and between horses, progressed gradually to bid inside of the leader in the final furlong and edged past. WARRIOR RICHARD tracked along the inside, ranged up outside of the top pai to bid in the four path turning for home, gained an advantage in upper stretch but was collared by an inner bidder in the final furlong and got bested late. C F V BULLET pursued from midpack in the three path, then at the rear between horses around the far turn, moved out to the four to five path in upper stretch and stayed on willingly. DAI VERNON bumped with an outer foe at the start, trailed in the four to five path, chased five to six wide in upper stretch then surpassed a tiring inner pair in the final furlong. TRES SOLES set the pace along the inside, vied with an outer rival down the backstretch, then an outer pair turning for home before fading in midstretch. SALTWATER COWBOY bumped with an inner foe at the start, raced forwardly in the three path, tugged to vie two wide down the backstretch, then between horses turning for home, but got headed in upper stretch and weakened through the final furlong.

LADY JANCIS showed the way in the two path while remaining in hand around the turn, responded when set down in upper stretch, shook free and drew off under mild urging. ZERO ABSOLUTE bumped with an outer rival at the start, raced close up between horses, brushed an outer foe before stalking from the three path around the bend, offered a bid outside of the eventual winner reaching the lane, but was turned away in upper stretch, proved no match and was second best. CEARNACH tracked while tucking two wide into the turn, changed leads while vying for show in midstretch, dueled for that position thereafter and prevailed. HEITZGIRL stalked along the inside, chased into upper stretch, dueled for show while hanging on her left lead through the final furlong and missed. LAST CURTAIN CALL settled two wide, advanced between horses passing the three furlong pole then stayed on mildly. BEAU CUP bumped with an inner foe soon after the start, raced close up in the four path, got brushed by an inner foe into the turn, recovered to stalk from the three path then faded. EVE lacked speed in the two path then moved up. STRAWBERRY FLOAT broke slowly, trailed along the inside then improved between horses. FRAUD ALERT was bumped between horses at the start, raced off of the pace in the five path, got forced wider by an inner bolter into the turn and weakened. MUNDY SWEEP pursued from midpack three wide and between horses, bore out and steadied hard into the turn then weakened. FASHION QUEST pursued four wide and between horses, got forced outwardly and steadied among foes at the three furlong pole then faltered. IN SPEIGHT OF ZOOM raced forwardly along the inside, steadied into the turn then caved.
