DOLCE VINO vied two wide, dueled with her inner counterpart in upper stretch, drove clear in the final furlong then held sway. WARM UP THE BUS broke a step slow, laid at the rear in the four path, advanced five wide into the lane, rallied outside of foes to take aim on the newly clear leader in the final sixteenth but was kept at bay. FERMI leaned outwardly at the start, stalked four wide, then between horses around the turn, chased among foes into the lane, stayed on through the final furlong and edged show late. B D'S ANGEL led narrowly inside of the eventual winner into and around the turn, dueled with that one through upper stretch, but yielded leaving the furlong grounds then lost show in the shadow of the wire. DIVINEINTERVENTION bumped with an inner foe and steadied when put to crowded quarters between foes early on, tracked five wide, ranged up to take aim from the four path entering the lane, but flattened out in the final furlong then missed show between rivals at the wire. BRIGHT LADY DAY prompted three wide and between horses, came under urging to maintain position around the turn but gave way in upper stretch. BELONGTOTHENAVY broke a beat slow, rushed forward along the inside early

on, but steadied hard behind the leaders at the five furlong pole, chased along the inside around the turn then yielded. LISTENTOURMOTHER bumped with an outer rival and checked between horses early on, chased two wide and between horses, leaned to the three path around the turn then weakened.
