RANDIE'S RASCAL (GB) set the pace along the inside as an outer rival applied pressure, drew off in upper stretch then held sway under moderate urging. AUGUST pursued from midpack along the inside then rallied up the rail to duel for place with an outer rival in the final sixteenth and prevailed. SMOKE TRAIL bumped with a n outer foe at the start, stalked along the inside, tipped off in upper stretch, ran on to forge place while lugging about into the final sixteenth, sparred with an inner bidder for that position late but got outfinished. GOOD TO BE KING broke a beat slow, raced ell back in the three path, fanned six wid einto th elane, rallied to vie for fourth with an inner co-charger in the late stages and prevailed. GENERATIONAL was bumped between horses at the start, laid well back near the inside, shifted out four wide and between horses entering the lane, rallied along with an outer rival to vie for fourth with that one late but missed. WARTIME pressed outside of the eventual winner, but proved no match in upper stretch and faded. EZ PAL leaned inwardly and bumped a foe at the start, tracked from the two path, shifted out to the four path entering the lane, but lugged inwardly shortly after then faltered in hand. GET YOUR STEPS IN came in at the start, raced off of the pace in the two to three path into the lane then failed to menace before steadying behind traffic at the sixteenth pole. EPIC ROLL broke a step slow, trailed in the three path and got outrun. BAYTOWN DA VINCI broke a step slow, saved ground off of the pace then tired.

DERBY DATE stalked outside of the top pair, bid turning for home, dueled with an inner foe through midstretch and edged past. CATAMOUNT led narrowly from an outer prompter, vied with an outer pair turning for home, dug in to duel with his widest counterpart into the final furlong but got bested. BE HERE settled off of the pace along the inside then rallied to offer a late bid for show and prevailed. GLOBAL SENSATION bumped with an inner foe at the start, raced at the rear two wide, advanced between horses while moving out to the four path passing the three furlong pole, fanned five wide into the lane then rallied to miss show at the wire. FURIOUS ANGER bumped with an outer rival at the start, chased from midpack in the three path, four path and between horses into the lane then ran on willingly among rivals. ILLINI prompted two wide, vied around the turn, then between horses turning for home then faded in midstretch. FIFTY CENT DOLLARS broke outwardly, raced off of the pace in the four path and failed to factor.

FOUNTAIN RUN set the pace as an outer rival applied pressure, vied with that one around teh far turn, got headed in upper stretch, yet fought on gamely to battle once again in the final furlong and prevailed. GEWURZTRAMINER prompted outside of the eventual winner from the three path, vied with that one around the far turn, forged an advantage and moved a touch wider in upper stretch, but failed to kick on, dueled with his inner game counterpart in the final sixteenth and missed. MY NOBLE KNIGHT tracked along the inside, chased in the two path around the far turn then ran on evenly. C F V BULLET raced off of the pace near the two path, shifted out in midstretch and stayed on mildly. MILITARY ROAD stalked from the two to four path into the backstretch then faded rounding the far turn. MOWINS turned his head as the gates sprung and broke multiple lengths slow, trailed along the inside, moved out to the three path entering the backstretch then failed to factor.

SPEEDSTORM broke inwardly, vied two wide and between horses before backing off to stalk, bid three deep in upper stretch, inched clear in midstretch, got collared by an outer bidder in the final sixteenth yet held. ATTERSEE raced forwardly along the inside, stalked around the turn, shifted four wide entering the lane, tipped wider in upper stretch, rallied to offer a late bid but missed at the wire. PALACIOS was bumped and crowded between horses at the start, lagged behind along the inside, rallied to split foes three wide in the final furlong and settled for show. BOURBON'S FAULT brushed with an outer rival at the start, vied for the lead along the inside, kept on into midstretch then yielded. SOCIAL HOUR stalked four to three wide, inched closer around the turn, took aim four wide in upper stretch but flattened out then yielded between horses. EASY DIAL bumped and was put to tight quarters between horses at the start, raced off of the pace in the four path and failed to factor. SUPERCHARGER broke a step slow, trailed in the two path, swung seven wide into the lane, rallied with a good kick to reel in the leaders at the furlong grounds and drove clear. TELESCOPIC saved ground off of the pace, awaited racing room around teh far turn, continued to encounter traffic in upper stretch, tipped in but got outkicked while offering a rail bid in midstretch then ran on to prove second best. MY BOY TONY brushed with an outer foe at the

start, saved ground well back, encountered traffic turning for home, remained blocked three wide behind rivals through midstretch, shifted inwardly at the sixteenth pole and ran on willingly to edge show late. RAPOPORT tracked along the inside, slipped through to issue a rail bid entering upper stretch, led briefly before getting headed by bidders on both sides in midstretch, yielded and lost show late yet lasted for fourth. ROTHSCCHILD stalked three wide, pressed the top pair around the far turn, floated five wide and between horses in upper stretch, stayed on mildly after getting outkicked and missed fourth at the wire. MARY'S BOY BOLT pressed two wide, bid between horses around the far turn, vied three wide in upper stretch then gave way. TAUNTING brushed with an inner rival leaving the gate, lacked speed in the three to four path, then then two path around the far turn, shifted out seven wide in the final furlong and failed to factor. KING OF ASHES tracked two wide and among foes, chased forging four wide and between rivals in upper stretch but failed to menace. BLAST FURNACE pursued from midpack three to four wide, fanned six wide into the lane, got outkicked and gave way. DEMETRIUS set the pace along the inside, got headed between horses in upper stretch and weakened.
