BARKER tracked three wide, bid outside of the new leader at the three furlong pole, forged an advantage entering the lane, drove clear in midstretch and held sway. BEDEVILED broke a step slow and was briefly put in tight between rivals at the start, lacked speed two wide and between horses yet rallied through the lane to gain place from among foes passing the sixteenth pole. SEQUOIA STARS pursued from midpack in the two path, advanced between horses at the five sixteenths pole, shifted out to the five path entering the lane, ran on to bid for place at the sixteenth pole, but got outkicked by an inner rival and held show from an outer foe. MAX IS HIM broke inwardly and steadied off a rival's heels at the start, trailed in the two path, swung seven wide into the lane, rallied to offer a late bid for show but missed. SILVER SNIPER pressed two wide, led into the turn, met an outer challenge shortly after, got headed by that one entering the lane then faded in the final furlong. BLUE MOUNTAINS broke a step slow before being briefly put in tight between horses at the start, raced off of the pace in the three path, shifted to the six path into upper stretch and failed to menace. MEANSTEPPER lacked speed along the inside despite rider's urging, steadied slightly when maneuvering around a faltering foe at the five sixteenths pole but failed to factor. ACCORD tracked two wide and between horses, floated to the five path entering the lane and weakened. FERAL stalked along the inside, chased in the two path into the lane and faded. CULPER CODE broke a step slow, lacked speed three wide, fanned to the five path into the lane and made little impact. AUTHENTIC PATRIOT set the pace along the inside down the backstretch, but got headed by an outer presser entering the turn then wilted around the bend.
