URBAN PLANNER bumped with an inner foe at the start, settled along the inside, advanced inside of foes with nine sixteenths to go, moved to the three path and between horses while within striking range turning for home, took aim outside of the leader and from the four path entering the lane, ranged up to bid in midstretch and drove clear. EXPECT THE BEST was bumped between horses at the start, settled in the two to three path, moved to the inside while picking up stride in upper stretch and rallied to edge place late. AWESOME RUTA was bumped between horses at the tart, vied two wide, led in the three path around the far turn, got collared by an outer bidder in midstretch, was bested by that one shortly after and lost place to an inner bidder late. JUST A FAIR SHAKE led narrowly while vying with an outer rival into and down the backstretch, got headed by that one into the far turn, fought on in upper stretch but gave way at the furlong grounds. GLEN AIRY steadied into the first turn, tracked from the three to four path, floated six wide into the lane then ran on mildly. OVERSTATEMENT raced off of the pace in the two path, shifted to the five path into the lane and failed to factor. CLOONEY pressed three deep, roused to sustain pressure around the far turn, faded. CALYCANTHUS bumped with an outer rival at the start, tracked near the inside then tired. WELAKA raced off of the pace in the four path, trailed down the backstretch, moved to the six to seven path in upper stretch and made little impact.
