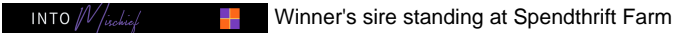

SHOW TIME stalked in the four path, bid entering the lane, wrestled an advantage at the furlong grounds while dueling with an inner rival and held firm. AMERICAN XPERIMENT prompted outside of the leader and from the three path, vied turning for home, then between horses as an outer SHOW TIME bid entering the lane, sparred gamely with that one through the final furlong but was denied. MIDNIGHT PRANKS saved ground off of the pace, moved out to the four path and between horses leaving upper stretch and ran on willingly. GUANARE pursued from midpack in the five to four path, floated back to the

five path in upper stretch and stayed on one paced. NABOKOV broke half a beat slow while last away, tracked along the inside, chased in upper stretch and yielded. LIGHTNING STRUCK raced off of the pace two wide and between horses and failed to factor. MUMAYAZ showed the way in the two path as an outer rival prompted around the turn, then faded between horses in upper stretch. PURE PANIC raced off of the pace three wide and failed to factor. TOP GUN TOMMY lacked speed outside of rivals, trailed while tucking to the inside turning for home and made little impact.
