SOUL OF THE NIGHT bumped with an inner rival at the start, pressed five to three wide into the turn, chased the embattled leading pair around the turn,

sustained gradual progress to forge even terms at the sixteenth pole and drove past. GREATEST BLAZE vied along the inside, dueled with an outer rival around the turn, disposed of that one while getting collared by a wider challenger in the final furlong and was bested late. HEX APPEAL vied two wide, sparred around the turn but weakened to the eventual top pair at the sixteenth pole. BLAME TO FAME pursued from midpack in the four path and between horses into the turn then ran on mildly to prove best of the rest. CORNICHE ROAD brushed with an outer foe at the start, lacked speed along the inside then moved up between horses. ACERBIC broke slowly, trailed in the four path then improved between horses. TUMBLING raced forwardly six to four wide into the turn, gave way in the five path leaving the three furlong pole then failed to menace outside of foes. PASSAGE DU DESIR bumped with an outer rival at the start, raced off of the pace in the five to four path and failed to factor. TWENTY THREE GOLD lacked speed in the two path, advanced reaching the lane but failed to reach contention before flattening out. DEVIOUS LADY brushed with an inner foe leaving the gate, raced forwardly three wide before tucking to chase along the inside into the turn, but tired through the lane. PUTNAM MARKET was fractious behind the gate, broke outwardly, tracked seven to five wide and outside of foes into the turn, but gave way in the six path leaving the three furlong pole and tired.
