SPECIAL SAUCE set the pace along the inside, led from an outer trio of prompters around the turn, drew off entering the lane then held sway under moderate urging. GOOD CALL prompted two wide, then between hroses around the turn, but proved no match while leaning to the three path entering the lane then held place between pursuers. TEMPTING EVE broke a beat slow, tracked along the inside, vied for show through the final furlong and prevailed. REVEL TOAST pressed three wide, then between foes around the turn, yielded in the four path entering the lane, vied for show between rivals through the final furlong but got outfinished. TETIAROA broke a step slow and trailed early on, advanced four wide approaching the turn, pressed outside of the leading trio around the bend, but gave way in the five path entering the lane then kept on mildly. JUST DO BELIEVE trailed in the three path and failed to factor.
