CRITIKAL SENSE prompted two wide, forged an advantage in the three path entering the lane and drove clear. SPILL THE SUGAR was jostled between horses at the start, raced off of the pace two wide and between horses into the turn, swung four then five wide into the lane, shifted inwardly and rallied to gain place late. YAIRA raced close up along the inside, stalked from the two path turning for home, took aim on the new leader from the four path in upper stretch but proved no match and yielded place late. ALABAMA GETAWAY was bumped by an inner foe at the start, stalked three wide, chased when floated to the five path into upper stretch yet kept on. DIZZY MISS LIZZY bumped with an inner foe leaving the gate, pursued from midapck two wide and between horses, shifted three wide turning for home then stayed on mildly. CLEAR FORK broke a step slow, trailed in the three path then improved position. CRYSTAL FROST was jostled and pinched back between horses at the start, lacked speed in the four to six path and failed to menace. DOMINA D'ORO bumped an outer foe at the start, saved ground off of the pace to no avail. MAGIC CLASS set the pace as the eventual winner applied outer pressure, got bested by that one entering the lane and weakened. DONNA STRADA tracked from the two path then weakened between horses while hanging on her left lead. BUCKEYE FAVORITE pursued from the four path then faded between horses turning for home. MURIEL SAX broke outwardly and bumped a foe at the start, chased along the inside, but began to ease turning for home, pulled up in midstretch and was transported off of the track in an equine ambulance.
