NYMIRA was bumped between horses and steadied back when squeezed soon after the start, trailed along the inside, shifted five wide while picking up stride entering the lane then rallied to reel in the leader nearing the wire. ESTARDOTOO bumped with an outer foe soon after the start, stalked two wide, tipped outside of the top pair turning for home to bid entering the lane, forged an advantage passing the three sixteenths pole, held sway through midstretch but was collared by an outer challenger in the final sixteenth and got bested late. LECOMPTE'S RUN vied for the lead with an outer rival while near the inside, disposed of that one as a wider rival bid entering the lane, got headed by that one at the three sixteenths pole, fought on through the final furlong then saved show late. NEW PURPOSE settled along the inside, saved ground around both turns, rallied into the final furlong, split foes in the three path at the sixteenth pole but missed show at the wire. GONE AND PLENTY tracked along the inside, sustained a rail chase through the lane but lacked a bid. EPERNAY pursued from midpack in the three path and between horses, checked when an inner troubled foe shifted across his path leaving the five furlong pole, chased two wide and between horses around the far turn, shifted to the four path in upper stretch and lacked progress. TRUE SILVER J P laid off of the pace hung five to four path and failed ot menace. SONGADEEWIN bumped with an inner foe soon after the start, laid off of the pace in the four path and between horses, then two wide around the far turn, swung to the six path into the lane and failed to factor. DONIE MARONIE pulled in the four path to vie

with an inner rival around the first turn, prompted in the two path around the far turn but faded between horses entering the lane and weakened while hanging on his left lead. TECHWERKIAN was bumped between horses soon after the start, steadied when uncomfortable shortly after, pursued in midpack under a hold in the two path around the first turn, moved out wide passing the five furlong pole, eased around the far turn, pulled up entering the lane, was found to have bled then transported off of the track in an equine ambulance.
