MAJIK MOONEY brushed with an outer foe leaving the gate, settled along teh inside, waited two wide and between horses turning for home, split foes in the five path in upper stretch, rallied to bid outside of the top pair in the final sixteenth and bumped an inner rival while edging past nearing the wire. BEARAMOUR set a clear pace, met a pair of outer challenges around the far turn, dueled with an outer THAT'S FIRE through the lane but got outkicked late and saved place. THAT'S FIRE brushed with an inner foe leaving the gate, stalked two wide, bid between horses turning for home, battled with the inner early-leader through the lane but got outkicked and bumped by an outer bidder nearing the wire and missed place. HIT THE HIGH NOTE was off slow, trailed in the two path, shifted to the four path with nine sixteenths to go, fanned six wide in upper stretch yet rallied widest in the final furlong to miss show. SPIES LIKE US broke inwardly, stalked along the inside, awaited racing room rounding the far turn, chased in the three path in upper stretch, brushed with an outer foe passing the three sixteenths pole and lacked a bid. LINE ASTERN pursued from midpack three wide, bid outside of the top pair around the far turn but yielded in the four path in upper stretch, brushed between horses passing the three sixteenths pole and faded. SIR HANSEN stumbled severely at the start, pulled up around the first turn then walked off.
