MAGNIFICENT RAGS broke a step slow, then bumped with an outer rival while checking between horses shortly after the start, tracked near the two path, then in the three path and between horses into the far turn, shifted out to the five path to take aim outside of the embattled leading pair in upper stretch, sustained gradual progress to bid at the sixteenth pole and edged past. COME TO PAPA stalked three wide, moved to press the leader from the three path into the far turn, bid and dueled in the four path in upper stretch, led narrowly into the final furlong but got caught by an outer bidder in the late stages. LEBOMBO vied two wide, led into the backstretch, felt pressure from an outer rival while remaining in the two path around the far turn, battled with that one in the three path in upper stretch, fought on while through the final furlong but got bested. ICE SHOT laid off of the pace in the three to four path, spun in to the lane in the five path, leaned inwardly while hanging on his left lead, kept on to bid for fourth between horses while brushing with an inner co-bidder at the

WHAT'S UP DOC steadied out of cramped quarters between horses at the start, trailed in the two path, progressed in the four to five path turning for home, rallied to drive past the leaders at the sixteenth pole and drew clear. AMERICAN LAW tracked in the two path, took aim outside of the clear leader and from the three path turning for home, ranged up to bid in the four path entering the lane, forged an advantage in upper stretch but got outkicked by an outer bidder with a sixteenth to go. MAN IN THE CAN showed the way in the two path, built a clear margin entering the far turn, but was collared by an outer bidder while moving to the three path entering the lane, was bested by that one in upper stretch, outkicked for place at the furlong pole and was best of the rest. PANCAKE HOUSE pursued from midpack in the three path, chased while moving to the inside turning for home but lacked a bid. MASTEROFFOXHOUNDS pressed the leader from the three path, but failed to sustain pressure reaching the far turn and faded turning for home. TWO BEERS BY TEN saved ground off of the pace, but made little impact. BOLT AT MIDNIGHT broke a step slow then was awkward between horses shortly after, pursued from midpack in the four path, then weakened in the five path around the far turn and was eased through the lane.

CURVINO trailed in the two path, advanced in the four to five path and between horses around the far turn, swung out to the seven path into the lane, rallied to bid leaving upper stretch, forged an advantage at the furlong grounds then inched clear. STONEMONT REUNION pressed two wide, vied down the backstretch, led approaching the far turn, met an outer challenge while taking the far turn in the two path, shook free of that one in upper stretch, but was collared and headed by an outer bidder at the furlong grounds, yet fought on grudgingly. EXPECT THE BEST stalked along the inside, pursued two wide and between horses turning for home then willingly chased the top pair home. ANGLICAN settled in the two path, advanced in the three path and between horses with a half mile to go, chased within striking range in the four path around the far turn, but got outkicked by an outer rival entering the lane, kept on and re-edged fourth in the late stages.
