AMERICAN PEARL broke sharply to claim the early lead from the inside, came under pressure by PRONGHORN in the far turn, opened up by a couple of lengths in the upper stretch, held firmly through the finish to keep rallying foe at bay. WHITETHORN settled back to race off the pace in the two path, split foes in the far turn to make a four wide bid entering the stretch, began to rally in the stretch but flattened out late. SONHADOR was unhurried at the start to be the early trailer, quickly made progress along the inside of the far turn entering the stretch in a competitive position, passed tiring rival to be up for show. PRONGHORN pressed the pace from the two path, weakened in the final furlong. QUICK TO CHARM raced off the pace four wide, made no impact, eased across. SENSING FLATTER settled behind the pace in a tracking position from the inside, began a slow retreat in the far turn to trail in the final quarter, eased across.
