LOVE HER LOTS stalked along the inside, bid outside of the leader entering the lane, gained an advantage at the furlong grounds and drove clear. MORNING MIRACLE set a clear pace, dug in to resist an outer challenge entering the lane, sparred through midstretch, but was bested then held place. WINDY BAY tracked three to two wide before moving to the inside down the backstretch, tipped to the three path while chasing in upper stretch, ran on late but was denied place. STEAMPUNK bumped with an inner foe at the start, laid off of the pace three wide, swung out six wide into the lane and ran on evenly. MISSY BEE laid off of the pace along the inside, then two wide into the lane and failed to menace. SPOTTY SHOWERS pursued from midpack three to two wide, chased in the five path and between horses in upper stretch but lacked a bid while hanging on her left lead. LADY BLAKE was bumped between horses at the start, raced off of the pace two wide and between horses, shifted out to the six to seven path in upper stretch and failed to threaten. GRACELEADSUSHOME toss her head while a bit keen at teh start, saved ground in midpack but to no avail. HONEY HAULER bumped with an outer foe leaving the gate, stalked two wide, chased three wide around the far turn then faded between horses. BRITTANYSGLDNFAITH trailed in the two to three path and got outrun.
