MESQUITE took back from between horses at the start, but climbed behind foes and altered course outwardly leaving the wire for the first time, trailed in the three path, rallied five wide rounding the far turn, bid in the six path entering the lane, sparred with an inner foe while shifting inwardly in upper stretch, bumped that one at the furlong grounds, edged an advantage and held sway. LIBERTY VALANCE broke a step slow, laid off of the pace along the inside, surpassed an inner pair before moving back to the inside while progressing into the lane, rallied to bid inside of the top pair passing the furlong grounds but was fended off while gaining place. CARSON STREET tracked five wide, pursued within range outside of the top pair around teh far turn, bid in the five path and between horses entering the lane, dueled with an outer MESQUITE while getting floated in by that one in upper stretch, got bumped at the furlong grounds as an inner bidder joined the fray and yielded place late. MISTER LANDRY lacked speed along the inside, moved out around the far turn, swung to the eight path into the lane and ran on willingly to gain fourth. SILVER SHOT broke half a beat slow, laid off of the pace two wide, progressed four wide and between horses around the far turn, shifted out to the seven path into the lane, but flattened out and got outfinished for fourth. RING CURL stalked outside

of the leader and from the three path, offered a mild challenge in the two path around the far turn, chased while drifting to the four path into the lane and gave way. BEER RUN dueled for the lead with an outer rival, got headed by a wider challenger in midstretch, fought on gamely and held place. G T FIVE HUNDRED dueled for the lead two wide, got outkicked by an outer challenger in midstretch, yielded after flopping back to his left lead and got nailed to share show at the wire. AMOUDI BAY racked from the three path, moved out to the five path leaving upper stretch and ran on between horses to reach a share of show. CURLIN'S GESTURE broke a step slow, trailed in the four path, fanned out to the six path into upper stretch and stayed on willingly. ROWDY RIOT raced off of the pace in the two path and failed to factor. TROUBLE TIME broke a step slow, raced off of the pace in the three path and lacked a rally between horses. INNOVATOR broke slowly, saved ground in midpack and tired.
