KID TWIST raced forwardly along the inside, chased in the two path around the turn, ran on to edge place from between horses leaving the furlong grounds and held that position from his outer counterpart at the wire. JUST LIKE MAX tracked from the three path and between horses, pursued in the four path in upper stretch, ran on to vie for place with an inner foe through the final furlong but missed. SWUNG was forced out multiple paths by an inner rival at the start, trailed near the inside, shifted to the three path into upper stretch then moved up between rivals in the final furlong. NO BEES veered outwardly leaving the gate, pursued outside of rivals and from the four path around the turn, floated out to the six path into the lane and gave way. GLOBAL QUOTE was bumped on both sides and put in tight between horses at the start, settled off of the pace in the two path, shifted out four wide at the three furlong pole, progressed quickly to assume command entering the lane, then drew off under a drive. HARBOR PRINCE bumped with an inner foe at the start, pursued from midpack in the two to three path into the backstretch, shifted out to the five path into the lane and ran on to claim place in the final furlong. SOUND CAUSE laid off of the pace in the three to two path, paused behind rivals turning for home, continued to encounter traffic entering the lane, shifted out to the fie path in upper stretch, rallied and shifted inwardly passing the furlong grounds and edged show in the final sixteenth. PACIFIC STANDARD tracked three deep, chased between horses around the far turn, got outkicked by his outer counterpart nearing the lane, kept on to claim place in upper stretch, but yielded that position between bidders in the final furlong. VINO DOMINUS came in at the start, pressed two wide, but faded between horses nearing the five sixteenths pole and steadied leaving that station. RANDO was bumped by an inner foe leaving the gate, saved ground off of the pace, progressed around the turn to bid inside of the leader entering the lane, forged an advantage while sparring with an outer SPYING leaving upper stretch, battled with that counterpart through the final furlong but got bested. SURPRISE bumped an outer foe at the start, tracked near the inside, then from the two to three path around the turn, got outkicked by an inner foe while moving three wide and between horses into the lane, then willingly chased the embattled top pair thereafter and was best of the rest. QUEEN OF QUEENS tracked three wide, progressed along with an outer rival turning for home, bid in upper stretch, forged an advantage at the three sixteenths pole and held firm from her outer counterpart. BELLSONHERSHOES raced off of the pace four wide and between horses approaching the turn, advanced four wide and outside of rivals around the bend, bid in the five path in upper stretch, sustained her challenge through the final furlong but was fended off and managed place. THE TOWN TEMPTER laid off of the pace in the five to four path into the turn, swung out to the six to seven path in upper stretch, rallied to duel for show with an inner rival in the final sixteenth and prevailed at the wire. PIPPA'S NONCENTS broke a step slow, raced well back in

the two to three path, then between horses around the turn, swung out to the six path while advancing into the lane, rallied to claim show in the final furlong, dueled for that position with an outer counterpart through the closing stages but got nailed at the wire. BANA pursued from midpack in the two path, chased in the four to five path in upper stretch, got outkicked and moved up. PUSHING THROUGH raced well back in the six path, tucked down to the four to three path around the turn, ran on to encounter traffic passing the furlong grounds and stayed mildly between horses. OAKS STREET stalked along the inside, chased in the two path into the final furlong and lacked a bid. FIZZY GIRL showed the way along the inside, built a clear margin while well in hand around the turn, but got headed by an outer bidder in upper stretch and weakened. TIZZLIN raced close up outside of the leader, chased that one around the turn, got outkicked by an outer pair entering the lane and weakened between horses.
