LAUGHNOWCRYLATER was forwardly placed racing three-wide, moved up to join THRILLA nearing the quarter pole, dueled with that one to the wire and prevailed under strongly handling. THRILLA prompted BAYTOWN BRUISER racing two-wide, moved up to join that one nearing the quarter pole, then dueled with LAUGHNOWCRYLATER from that point, got subtly headed at the sixteenth pole, fought on gamely but failed to regain even terms. EXCEL CALCULATOR settled in the back of the field early, angled out to come five-wide into the stretch and rallied late. DID IT DIALED came in and bumped a foe soon after the start, then checked back from between horses when brushed by that rival early on, raced off of the pace while getting brushed to the three path and between horses around the first turn, tucked to the inside into the far turn, tipped two wide and between horses entering the lane, rallied willingly to duel for show with an outer foe in the final sixteenth but missed,. PAPA YO was allowed to settle while racing four-wide and finished well in a steady effort. BAYTOWN BRUISER saved ground setting the pace, drifted out slightly entering the stretch and weakened during the drive. BOURBON SOCIETY settled in the middle of the field racing three-wide and lacked a rally. ANGLICAN bobbled and bumped with an inner foe at the start, was forwardly placed early racing bear the inside and tired. UTOPIAN was forwardly placed to the stretch racing along the inside and gave way during the drive. BEYOND BEST was unhurried, came six-wide into the stretch and was not a factor. MORAL showed brief speed along the inside, retreated while restrained to keep from lugging out around the first turn, gave way after a half mile and was eased nearing the stretch.
