PROCTOR STREET bumped with an inner foe at the start, tracked along the inside, then in the tree path and between horses turning for home, encountered traffic entering upper stretch, split foes at the furlong grounds, forged an advantage in the aftermath and held firm. AWESOME CZECH stalked along the inside, took rail aim in upper stretch, bid in midstretch, but was fended off late then saved place. FLEETINGLY broke a step slow and was bumped by an outer rival at the start, settled off of the pace two wide, swung out to the six path into the lane, rallied after floated to the seven path at the sixteenth pole and missed place at the wire. ADRASTEIA pursued from midpack in the three to four path, pursued in the five path in upper stretch, tipped out to the six path while between rivals at the sixteenth pole and ran to narrowly reach fourth. PIN UP BETTY stalked in the three path, bid two wide around teh far turn, drifted out to the four path in upper stretch, vied between horses before getting outkicked by an inner bidder at the furlong grounds, then got unfinished between horses and missed fourth. VIVE VEUVE bobbled subtly while breaking towards the front, tracked three wide, ranged up turning for home, fanned to the five path into upper stretch, bid and vied into the final furlong, but got outkicked between horses and missed fourth. DUVET DAY (IRE) pursued from midpack along the inside, then in the three path and between horse in upper stretch but lacked a bid. SABALENKA broke outwardly and was off slow, lacked speed two wide, swung out to the five path into the lane and failed to factor. LUCKY SPEECH bumped with an inner foe at the start, saved ground off of the pace but to no avail. MIWA (GB) broke a step slow and was bumped by an outer foe at the start, trailed along the inside, then in the two path around the far turn and made little impact. STYLISH SUE set a clear pace while well in hand into the far turn, dug in in the two path in upper stretch

then weakened between horses leaving midstretch.
