ALAPOCAS was off a step slow and settled early, advanced two wide and eased out nearing the five-sixteenths and came four wide by the quarter pole and closed well on the outside to go on even terms for command by the sixteenth marker and then got up late to prove best under a drive. FISSION was away alertly to set the pace in the two path, dug in gamely nearing the furlong marker and was headed leaving the sixteenth marker but yielded late. THE GABE DIGGER prompted the pace along the rail and angled off the inside leaving the turn but lacked room nearing the furlong marker and angled back in to the inside but found not enough room inside the furlong ground and then altered course again late while running on to best the rest. X G MAN prompted the pace and made a three wide bid on the turn and then was in between rivals nearing the furlong marker and steadied, angled out for clear racing room but flattened out. DONA MARIA was off a step slow and chased the pace four wide and was three wide by the quarter pole and weakened. JIMMIJAC was off very slowly and then was outrun while on the rail into the lane.

WILL BELIEVE dueled for command along the rail and came off the rail to be two wide by the quarter pole and was sent down leaving the three-sixteenths and dug in determinedly to prevail late. DAENERYS was off a half a step slow and then was rated along the rail, moved closer by the five-sixteenths and moved off the inside leaving the turn and angled out three to four wide by the quarter pole, then closed well but could not get to the winner late while gaining the place award. SQUIRRELY dueled for command on the outside and raced in the four to three path on the turn, moved in leaving the turn while still dueling for command with the winner and then was in between rivals by the sixteenth marker and was out-kicked late. ICESPIONAGE tracked the dueling leaders two wide on the turn and then was forced out four to five wide by the quarter pole and flattened out then weakened in the final furlong. FAR AWAY EYES was very fractious in the gate, broke alertly and showed brief speed three wide and then fell back, moved out to be six wide into the lane while being empty.

NO TEMPERANCE was off a step slow, settled two wide on the first turn and then moved out to be three wide entering the far turn and advanced four wide by the quarter pole, came five wide off the turn and closed well to draw away to prove best under a drive on the left lead the final sixteenth. MARGIE'S LAST was well rated early two wide, then advanced three wide by the quarter pole and made a four wide bid leaving the turn but could not go with the winner in the final sixteenth while being second best. KISS THE RING stalked the early pace three wide on the first turn, then moved up to vie for command three to two wide down the backside, continued two wide on the far turn and then was in between rivals leaving the three-sixteenths and faded in the final furlong while winning the show battle. OBJECTION set the pace two wide entering the first turn and then dropped to the inside and then was headed entering the backside and vied for command onto the far turn, then fought gamely to the furlong marker but faded in the final furlong and lost the show award late. BOUNDLESS SKIES tracked the pace along the rail, checked leaving the three furlong marker and fell back then had no late rally. HILL COUNTRY was reserved early two wide and then had outside pursuit down the backside and was three wide by the quarter pole but had no rally. TARGET MARKET was reserved early and on the inside, between rivals leaving the turn and was not a threat.

LOUIE THE SUN KING was settled early and made steady advance on the outside, made a four wide run on the turn and came five wide off the turn to make a bid and led in the final sixteenth but was denied on the wire. NORMANDY HERO stalked the pace and made a three wide bid leaving the turn to be clear by the furlong marker but faded late while lasting for the show award. DOCTOR JEFF was settled back and trailed early on the inside, swung out five wide and then angled farther out to have a good late rally on the outside. HEDWIG chased the pace and was in between rivals by the three eighths marker and two wide, came three wide off the turn and had a mild late kick. CACTUS tracked the early pace along the inside and then checked repeatedly entering the far turn while eager, then settled midway on the turn and came two wide off the turn and finished willingly among traffic in the lane, brutal trip. XY SPEED was well placed along the inside but lacked the needed bid while being one paced. CELTIC PRIDE bumped a rival at the break and then went up to set the pace and raced in the two path on the turn while clear, then was headed leaving the three sixteenths and weakened in the final furlong. MAKEIT TO CHEYENNE bumped at the break, chased the pace three wide and then steadied by the three furlong marker and weakened.

THE FED'S PLOT was allowed to settle early, made a three wide run by the quarter pole and was slowly gaining late but had to settle for being second best. LEGEND'S THUNDER vied for the lead on the inside and then tracked the winner while still on the inside, moved off the inside in upper stretch and fought on to the wire holding the show award. REBEL PRINCE was squeezed back at the break and trailed early, two wide on the far turn and angled out leaving the far turn and had a belated rally on

the far outside. DARE DEFYING was allowed to settle early, three wide by the quarter pole but had no late punch and needed more. SILVER DIME was allowed to settle early, made a four wide move by the quarter pole but flattened out. REVOLUTION ROCK was reserved early on the inside, two to four wide on the far turn but lacked a solid rally. GREAT HUNT chased the pace and was two wide on the far turn but tired in the lane. THEY NOT LIKE US was settled back early and never factored. GOLD RULES chased the pace on the inside and retreated. BETTER DAY tracked the pace two wide and then was in between rivals by the half mile marker, dropped to the rail entering the far turn but tired.
