STATE CONCEAL tracked the pace from the rail under mild coaxing on the turn, angled off the rail nearing the furlong marker and bumped with J C'S BOYS and then made a bid between rivals to hit the front with about eighty yards to go and edged clear to prove best under. OCEAN SOUND set a pressured pace and raced in the two path on the turn, then was collared leaving the sixteenth marker and could not hold off the winner while staying on for the place award. J C'S BOYS prompted the pace three wide and then came off the turn and loomed boldly by the three-sixteenths and was bumped by the furlong marker and kept on but needed more late. SHALI was off slowly, chased the pace two wide on the turn and swung out five wide leaving the turn and finished willingly but had no late punch. KUHNER was off a step slow, moved up on the outside to press the pace four wide and came four wide off the turn but weakened in the final furlong.

MAMBO QUEEN was reserved early and guided to the rail to save ground, moved out by the three furlong marker and advanced three wide and then tipped out four to five wide leaving the turn to make a bid and drew away in the final furlong to prove much the best. ALTAMIRA SUR was settled three wide and made a three wide move on the far turn to vie for command leaving the turn and then could not go with the winner in the final furlong while winning the place battle. MISS CALL stalked the leader and made a two wide bid by the five-sixteenths marker and vied for command in between rivals leaving the turn but proved to be no match for the winner while being out-kicked for the place award. SLEEPWALKER was rated along on the inside and moved out to be two wide by the quarter pole then was blocked behind rivals nearing the three-sixteenths and angled out for racing room and finished with some interest but had no punch. CALL HER BLUFF set the slow pace on the inside and was well handled, headed leaving the five-sixteenths and weakened in the final furlong. FLUFFY chased the pace two wide and came three wide into the lane and weakened.

MISS MO TOWN set the pace and crossed over to the inside and came two wide off the turn and then was kept to right handed crop urging to maintain a safe margin to prove best. KARA M S was bumped soundly at the break, chased the early pace and made a four to five wide move on the turn, came six wide by the quarter pole and kept on to the wire but could not get to the winner while being second best. KINDA KRAZY tracked the pace and raced two to three wide on the turn and lacked the needed winning bid while racing on paced. IRISH B GOODE was out-sprinted early and trailed, came five wide into the lane and angled out to the far outside and had a belated rally for the minor rewards. BLUMOOON FIRE broke out and bumped a rival at the break, then moved to the outside and made a five to six wide run on the turn, came seven wide off the turn but flattened out. DELTAWINNINGHAND tracked the pace along the rail and weakened. BEVERLY CRUSHER prompted the pace two wide and weakened. BERNIE RULES chased the early pace and steadied by the nine-sixteenths and then again on the turn and weakened. DEEVER ENCOUNTER stumbled at the break and chased the pace in between rivals three wide and then was empty.

ANTIOPE set the pace and then was pressured in the two path on the turn, shook clear leaving the five sixteenths and widened the margin leaving he three sixteenths and then held sway late to prove best under a mild drive. BRAVOJULIET broke in at the start and raced a little greenly early, then raced two to three wide on the turn and came four wide by the quarter pole, angled out and closed well in the final furlong but was too late, good effort. MOUNTAIN MAMBA was off a step slow and out-sprinted early, advanced leaving the five-sixteenths two wide and then angled out in the lane and split rivals leaving the sixteenth pole and finished well. ROYAL COMPANION chased the early pace and raced thee to four wide on the turn and came five wide by the quarter pole and had a mild late kick. POLL POSITION pressed the winner three wide and came four wide off the turn and weakened. EPIC STYLE was taken back early on the inside, moved to the outside down the backside and advanced three to four wide on the far turn, came seven wide off the turn and had a mild late kick. DI'S SURPRISE vied for the lead on the inside on the first turn, then tracked the winner from the rail on the far turn but faded in the drive. CITANA (ARG) was fractious in the gate, hit the gate leaving at the break, settled back two wide and then dropped to the inside and saved ground on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and improved late. DYNAMIC ACTRESS tracked the pace two to three wide and made a mild bid nearing the quarter pole and weakened. CAIRO STREET tracked the early pace along the inside and then chased the pace towards the inside and then the two path but tired. PRINCESS BETTINA was settled towards the inside, steadied by the five furlong peg and then was two to three wide on the far turn but tired in the lane. XANTHE was reserved early two wide, two to three wide on the far turn and tired.

TOO LOOSE LA TREK was reserved early and shuffled back to trail by the half mile marker, saved ground on the far turn under a hold, swung out six wide leaving the turn, shifted in by the three sixteenths and then corrected and closed well on the far outside getting up late to prove best under left handed crop. LIGHT DE NIGHT set the pace while clear and was well handled throughout, moved off the inside leaving the turn and was clear by the furlong marker but was caught late while saving the place award. SNOWGLOBE broke in and bumped a foe soundly and then was corrected and rated along three to two wide, continued two wide on the far turn and tipped out three to four wide and ran on willingly to the wire missing the place award. HOTTER THAN FIRE bumped at the break, was well placed early and then tracked the leader on the inside and was boxed by the quarter pole, cut the corner leaving the turn and

remained inside and kept on but was one paced and needed more. KISSED BY KARMA prompted the pace three to two wide and then was two wide on the far turn and came three wide off the turn and was still in contention by the furlong marker but faded late. WORKING ON IT was off slowly and spotted the field three lengths, three wide on the first turn, made a four wide middle move to stalk the leader, three wide on the far turn and came four wide off the turn but flattened out. IT'S FINE was rated along on the rail, shuffled back by the half mile marker, saved ground on the far turn and moved out leaving the turn and was roused but had no late punch. BAND ON THE RUN was bumped soundly and checked at the break, settled two wide and remained two wide to the quarter pole, came four wide off the turn but had no rally. THRESHING was reserved early on the inside, moved out down the backside and made a four wide run but weakened in the lane. MAGGIES BREW was settled back early and had outside pursuit down the backside and was five wide on the far turn and came six wide into the lane and tired.
