RISK AND REGRET was well rated two wide early, moved closer on the far turn two to three wide and came four wide off the turn to make a bid and edged clear in the final sixteenth to prove best under a drive. BINT MISCHIEF tracked the pace along the inside and sat the pocket on the far turn and made a rail bid inside lane but was out-kicked by the winner while winning the place battle. APICTURESWORTH set the pace while unchallenged, pressured leaving the five-sixteenths and came two wide off the turn and gave way grudgingly and missed the place award. CORONA PRINCESS was off a half step slow and reserved on the inside, saved ground on the far turn and had a belated rally on the inside and angled out late. PALACE LIGHTS was allowed to settle on the inside and swung out four wide leaving the turn but had no late kick. COURAGEOUS DIANE was off a half a step slow and settled two wide and swung out five wide leaving the turn but had no rally. IVY GARDEN stalked the pace and made a three wide bid on the far turn to pressure the pace but came up empty in the drive.

SWEET LAURA was rated along the inside and saved ground on the turn, came two wide off the turn and then moved back to the rail to make a bid,was bumped and steadied nearing the furlong marker, then got thru and closed well to edged clear late to prove best. ESPECIALY was reserved on the outside and made a four wide move on the turn and hit the front by the furlong marker and was clear nearing the sixteenth marker but could not hold off the winner to the inside and had to settle for being second best. LIAM IN THE DUST stalked the pace and made a three wide bid leaving the turn to vie for command nearing the furlong marker between rivals but flattened out late while saving the show award. DYNA SOAR was allowed to settle early, three wide on the turn and swung out five wide leaving the turn, then moved in leaving the three sixteenths and had a good late kick. SPENCERIAN set a pressured pace on the inside and came two wide off the turn by the quarter pole and then came in and bumped the winner by furlong marker and then weakened. NAVANI was allowed to settle early and saved ground on the turn, angled out four wide leaving the turn and made a mild bid nearing the furlong marker but flattened out late. RAPIDO ROSA pressed the pace two wide and tired after five furlongs.

FLAME DANCER vied for the lead in the first furlong and then went on to set the pace and move to the inside on the turn while clear, kicked away leaving the turn and then maintained a safe margin to the wire to prove best under right handed crop urging. WISE AND ELEGANT was allowed to settle early, tucked in to be two wide on the turn, waited to the quarter pole and angled out to come five wide into the lane and closed the gap late but had to settle for being second best. THE MAGIC OFMOVIES lunged at the break, reserved early and saved ground on the turn, cut the corner leaving the turn and angled out for racing room and finished well late. BEYOND QUESTION was settled back early, two wide on the turn and angled out by the three-sixteenths and had a mild late rally. HOVEKOMA vied for the early lead and then tracked the winner from the inside and tipped out two wide leaving the turn and was roused but weakened. HALE BOP was off a half a step slow, rushed up on the outside to track the winner and be three wide on the turn and came four wide into the lane but weakened. DIP FANTASIA tracked the pace in between rivals on the turn and then faltered in the lane.
