CELTIC PRINCE vied for the lead on the inside and drew clear on the turn and then moved out in the lane while well clear and was ridden out to prove much the best. KEEN TALENT was settled early, came under a ride on the inside midway on the turn and swung out four wide leaving the turn but proved to be no match for the winner while clearly second best. LOMAX broke outwardly and was off slowly and slow into stride on the outside, advanced three to two wide on the turn and ran on to best the rest. SMOOTH AN EASY was settled back early, two to four wide on the turn and passed the tiring rivals. INTOLERABLE stalked the pace four wide and then chased the pace four to five wide on the turn and tired. STARSHIP MAGELLAN bobbled at the break and settled back on the inside and failed to menace. FLAMENCO STAR vied for the lead three wide and gave way on the turn. WHO'S YER MAN was settled early three wide and raced three to four wide on the turn and was taken to the outside and pulled up, walked off.
