CLOSE THE GATE bumped a rival shortly after the break, stalked the leaders in the three path on the turn and moved out to the four path by the five-sixteenths and made a five wide bid leaving the turn, then was put to a long drive and wore down the leader late to get up under a drive. TOCIK HALL was away alertly to set a pressured pace on the inside, raced on the inside to the two path on the turn, was headed leaving the turn and moved out to be three wide by the quarter pole, turned back that bid but was engaged by the winner by the furlong marker and dug in stubbornly but relented late to miss. STATE CONCEAL pressed the pace three wide and made a four wide bid leaving the turn by the quarter pole to go on even terms for command then was in between rivals nearing the furlong marker and flattened out while keeping on for the show award. SAV'N MONEY chased the pace on the inside and rode the rail on the turn but had no kick while keeping on while racing evenly. G Q WORTHY bumped after the break, chased the pace on the outside and raced four to five wide on the turn, came six wide off the turn and then angled in nearing the furlong marker and had a mild late kick but needed more.

IRONSIDES was reserved early two wide, made a three to four wide move on the far turn and came off the turn dueling with CLASS PHOTO and had a long drive with that rival and edged ahead late to prevail in a game score. CLASS PHOTO was settled early and moved to the rail to save ground to the five-sixteenths marker and eased off the rail and came five wide into the lane and closed well gaining the place award on the wire. BATTLE CALL was well rated early two wide and made a three wide bid nearing the five-sixteenths and dueled for command by the three-sixteenths inside of IRONSIDES and fought on determinedly to the wire but yielded late and lost the place award on the wire. WALTER ME LAD was well placed on the inside and rode the rail on the far turn but was boxed by the quarter pole, angled off the rail leaving the three-sixteenths and made a bid in the final furlong but needed more. WINE COLLECTOR broke in and bumped a foe at the start, settled two wide and swung out five wide leaving the turn and had a belated rally. EL DE LARRY bumped at the break and then went up to prompt the pace two wide and made a two wide bid by the five-sixteenths and came three to four wide off the turn but faded. BE HERE was reserved on the inside, moved out and raced three to five wide on the far turn and came seven wide into the lane but had no rally. RIGHHERE RIGHTNOW was settled on the inside but lacked a serious rally. DEVIL'S HARVEST set the pace and was pressured on the inside and gave way in the lane.

MON REVE tracked in the two path, was ridden in the four path around the turn, ranged up to take a narrow lead at the top of the lane, and forged clear. VELOCITY GIRL rated, was cued in the three path passing the three-eighths pole, angled out to the six path entering the stretch, and rallied to get up for place. SUNFLOWER STATE chased early, moved up in the four path early around the turn to bid in the three path passing the three-eighths pole, held the lead going by the five sixteenths, got overtaken by the winner at the top of the stretch, the finished evenly. SQUIRRELY was reluctant to load, then bumped with an outer foe at the start, set the pace inside, was cued from the rail passing the three-eighths pole, but lost the lead before the five-sixteenths, then yielded in the stretch. MARITAL TRUST stalked in the three path, came under pressure midway around the turn, floated out to the five path at the top of the lane, but weakened. CROSS OF VALOR bumped with an inner foe at the start, pressed the pace in the two path, was ridden between foes around the turn, but gave way.

DON'T TELL DEREN showed the wire entering the first turn and then let BUCKIN' RIGHT go and open up on the first turn and was well rated in the two path, made a bid two wide to be clear by the quarter pole and then drew off leaving the turn and remained clear to the wire while being kept to task. CLASSICALS FINALE was reserved early, advanced two to three wide on the far turn and came four wide into the lane and finished well to gain the place award. TOUR JETE was settled back early two to three wide, advanced three to five wide on the far turn and came seven wide into the lane and closed well to gain the show award. STELLA MARS was settled along the inside and then moved out to the two path leaving the five sixteenths and made a mild bid to the furlong marker but needed more late losing the show award bob.
