CAIRO STREET vied for the early lead in between rivals, then rated off the pace and moved to the inside entering the backstretch, slipped thru nearing upper stretch to make a inside bid and moved out when straightened in the lane and was clear in the three path by the furlong marker and then was kept safe late to prove best under a drive. NOTABLE EXCHANGE was well rated along the inside, shuffled back on the turn and then finished well up the inside to gain the place award. SEAT AT THE TABLE was rated along three wide and came four wide into the lane and finished well while being out-kicked for the place award. DAMASO vied for the lead on the outside and was three wide on the far turn but faded in the drive. DREAMING OF ABBA was allowed to settle making way towards the inside, two path on the far turn and swung out four to five wide and had a mild late kick. IRISH KITTEN was reserved early and made a four wide move nearing the quarter pole but flattened out and weakened. CORINNA was off a step slow and trailed early, moved to the outside and was three to four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the lane and had no rally. MAIRSILS FIRST vied for the lead on the inside and then moved off the inside leaving the five sixteenths and then gave way in the lane was eased to the wire.
