WESTSIDE TIDE broke out but forwardly, stalked the pace in the second flight off the inside, closer three wide second turn, bid, took over, found more late to repel the runner up. FUNNY UNCLE void of speed while racing off the inside, advanced four then five wide through the final turn, continued to steadily gain, lodged a mild bid outside the winner, turned back the final furlong. MALIBU MAMBO settled off the pace and the inside, asked along in the far turn, came four wide out of the final bend when within striking distance, lacked a closing punch, narrowly retained the show. IN A JAM rated while in mid pack

inside, continued to save ground second turn, enjoyed a clean trip along the rail into the lane and bettered his position with some moderate late interest. SPANISH NOBLE outrun while racing off the inside, bit closer three path late turn, in traffic into the stretch, switched out to be widest and improved a bit with some modest interest while well out in the course. NEXT LEVEL lacked speed while racing just off the inside, continued back, asked along into the lane, checked up behind a stopping rival past the furlong marker, recovered and improved position with some late interest. ONE TIME WILLARD behind the two leaders through the glib fractions, gave way turning for home. WHAT SAY THEE lacked speed inside, continued to save ground second turn and into the lane, in a bit tight with a furlong remaining, came up empty when clear. MONGOLIAN APPLE hustled vigorously away from the gate to show the way into the first turn, set a lively set of fractions then stopped through the lane. BAR FOURTEEN broke with leaders, prompted a quick set of fractions while racing off the inside, also stopped through the stretch.
