JUNGLE GLOW broke forwardly, fell back off the early leader inside, moved out and engaged that one in the two path midway on the turn, quickly clear when straightened for home, extended that advantage to the wire while being kept to task. NOAH CHANCE balked briefly loading, back off the pace and the inside, raced in the second flight while four deep through the turn, ran on to earn the place while proving no match for the winner through the lane. CATAMOUNT within striking distance early, moved inside through the turn when with the second group, long duel for the second spot, outkicked. INCINERATOR lacked early foot, came widest of the drive, found his best stride too late down the middle of the course. THEN WHAT TIME inn the second flight through the turn while between horses, came up empty for the drive. KOHOUTEK made little impact from well back while racing in the two path. WARHEART in mid pack while saving ground ground, lacked a closing response. MAKEIT TO CHEYENNE broke well, worked way clear after a quarter, responded when the winner came calling midway on the bend to briefly duel then could not keep up. MI DINERO finished early, trailed home to be outrun.
