PREACHA MEYERS pressured the pace from the three path, engaged the leader from the outside late in the turn, dueled through upper stretch and past the furlong marker, edged away late while under steady handling. PASCALINE broke up front, showed the way out of the chute, set the pace in the two path under a light hold, responded when challenged by the winner while in the two path turning for home, dueled with that one, proved stubborn before yielding in the late going, lasted for the second position in the final strides. LONESOME BOY lacked early foot, moved out for the run through the turn, five wide through most of the bend, began advancing into the stretch, continued to grind while well out in the strip, finished willingly while too late for the runner up spot. OMAHA OMAHA fell back to trail after the start, four path while in hand into the turn, improved inside of a rival or two when three wide entering the stretch, continued that mild advance in the run to the wire, surrendered the show late. DANCE SOME MO in some early traffic, encountered traffic again to lose some position with five furlongs remaining, moved out to race four wide through the turn, lacked a closing response through the lane. JUST A FAIR SHAKE last to leave, moved up to race within striking distance inside before exiting the chute, remained forward through the turn, had little for the stretch drive. CROSSLAND in mid pack early, lodged a mild mid move into the turn, gave way.
